Bank employees can be found volunteering, like helping in the park.

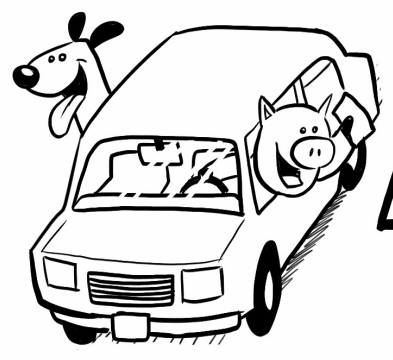


Bankers help neighbors with many different things including cashing checks, opening new accounts, applying for loans, and answering questions.



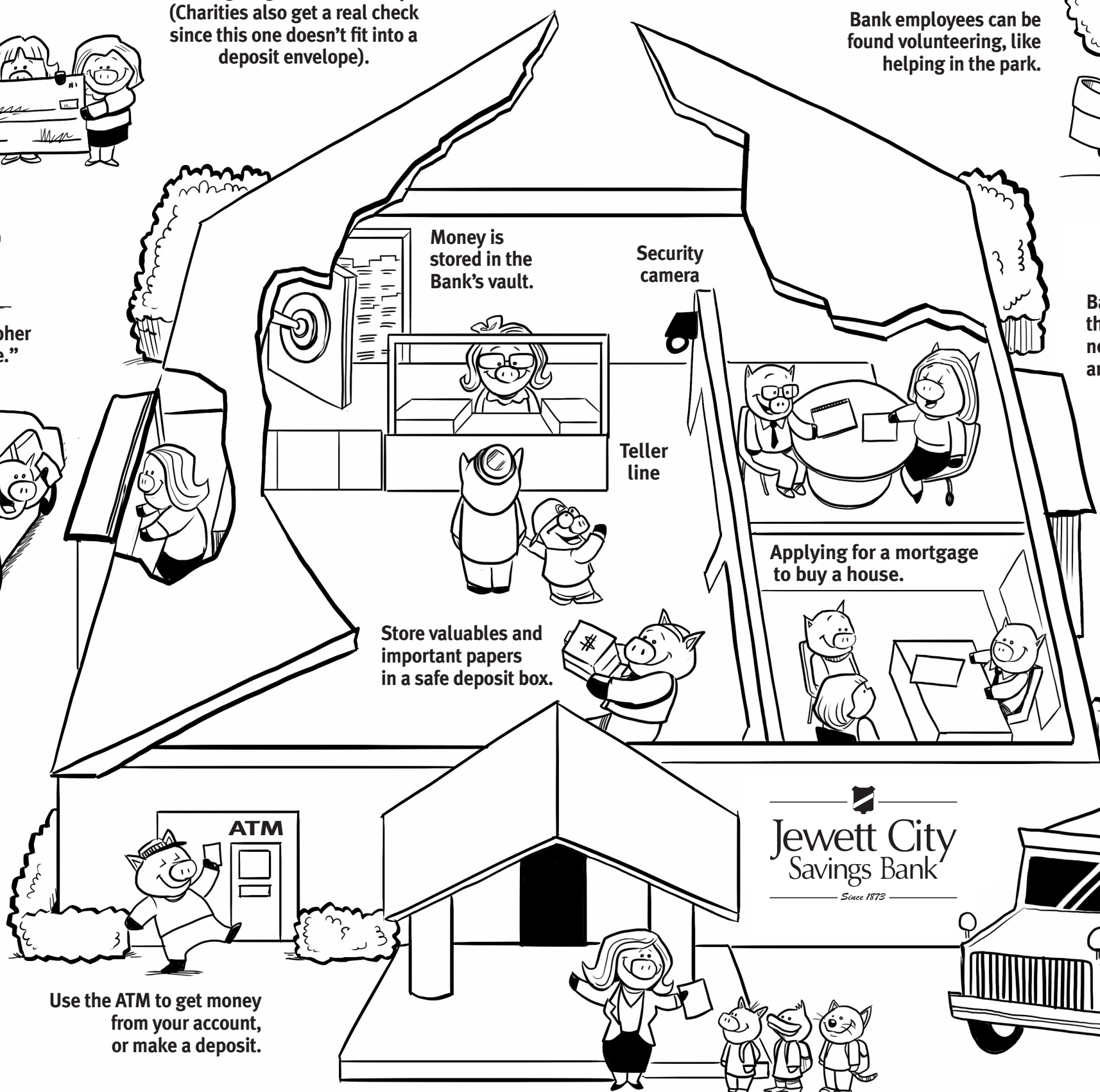
When the Bank is closed busy business owners use a special envelope to drop off deposits in the “night deposit.”
